## **Licensing**

Have you renewed your business and sales tax licenses with the Town of Ault? If you have not renewed your licenses please be sure to contact Mariah Nissen at [licensing@aultcolorado.gov](mailto:licensing@aultcolorado.gov) or (970) 834-2844 to receive business and sales tax applications. The current fee for each license is \$10.00. An additional \$10.00 per month will be charged for all licenses that are late. Business and sales tax licenses are valid from January 1st – December 31st of each year.





### **Public Works Reminders**

Please do not landscape over the meter pit lid or curb stop that is located on your property. Town code requires that these always remain visible and accessible to public works personnel.
