- **a.** Broadhead Sewer Project Bid schedule has been received, and bids are due June 3. Will be brought to Council for potential approval in June. Pre-bid meeting held.
- **b.** Perrine Street Originally to be done with Broadhead project. Setbacks with property permissions have caused delays.

- **c.** Ewing Road Received updated estimates for additional options. Forwarded information to the finance committee for discussion.
- d. C-20 Sewer Separation Project is currently at the Duncan / Steuben intersection and proceeding eastbound on Steuben St. PA American Water is doing water line relocations as needed. Mill and pave are scheduled for mid-June to include Duncan Street, Duncan/Steuben intersection and Steuben St. up to Crafton Park. Night work is to start Tuesday, May 27th and is expected to last a few days through Thursday evening. Night work on high volume roads significantly reduces the time required to complete the work. Night work is also expected in July on Steuben St. from Linden intersection to W. Crafton.
 - i. Project impacted roads include Steuben St. (W. Crafton to Duncan), Linden Ave. (Maxwell to Steuben), and Duncan Ave. (Maxwell to Steuben).
 - **ii.** Expected completion: 11/12/25.
- e. DPW Building Bids have closed, bid tabulations reviewed and a letter of recommendation for each contract was received with the lowest responsible and responsive bidders. The total for all 4 contracts including recommended add alternates is \$1,078,820.85 This is \$235,000 less than what was budgeted including the previously completed sewer line work and the excavation work that Crafton's Public Works crew will complete.
