Regional EMS Steering Committee Report: No report was given.

Fire Company: No report was given.

Director of Office Operations: No report was given.

Director of Parks and Recreation: Steve Bachman attended the July Northwestern Recreation Commission meeting. The Northwestern Recreation Commission reviewed the event, "A Night In The Country". Steve Bachman reported that the event made \$28,000 without expenses. Also, next year the Rec Commission will look into making signs, supplied by them, regarding closing the park 3 days in advance of the event. A car cruise admission fee for next year was discussed.

Director of Public Works: No report was given.

Road Superintendent: Kevin Huber reported that the road department finished oil and chipping on Hunsicker Road and oil and chipping is now complete. The road department also prepped for road paving and is getting base repair done on Hunsicker Road. The new tiger mower needed an adjustment but is fixed. Next, the road department will be working on the dirt roads.

Township Administrator: Janice Meyers reported that the check for the fire tax was written in the amount of \$14,962.78 for June, July and August. She attended the Senator Browne municipal grant workshop and will have a draft budget in the next couple of weeks. Tara Jones has been working on the 2014 Heidelberg Township Fall Newsletter. She received the 1st and 2nd draft, reviewed the drafts and made the necessary changes and corrections where needed. The final draft of the newsletter should be received next week. A yard waste survey was incorporated into the newsletter for the Heidelberg Township residents to complete and return. Roy Stewart, Janice Meyers and Tara Jones worked on numerous zoning issues.

Township Zoning Officer: Ryan Christman presented the Zoning Officer Report to the Board. The Zoning Officer Report included 3 complaint investigations. The first was an open burning complaint. A letter was sent to the property owner explaining the township burn ordinance. The second was an earth disturbance complaint. A site inspection was conducted with the LCCD representatives leading to several violations of the PA Code and the matter will be turned over to DEP for additional investigation. The third and final complaint occurred when a residential driveway was paved without a permit. A letter was sent to the property owner and the property owner applied for a permit.

Township Engineer: Ryan Christman reviewed the engineer's report with the Board which consisted of an update of the bridge repair and culvert replacements. Ryan Christman reported that Keystone Consulting Engineers suggest letting the Jones Road Culvert and Werleys Corner Culvert for bid in February. Keystone Consulting Engineers will begin preparing the plans and specifications for bidding. He reported that Keystone Consulting Engineers is working on the permit application for the Jones Road Culvert (dirt road). Ryan Christman also reported on the Rex Road Bridge painting and load posting. He mentioned that Sherwin-Williams representatives were met with to discuss the paint deterioration. Posting the recommended tonnage was also discussed.
